#### The Attributes of the Father's Love

1. The Father is love (1 John 4:8)
2. It is eternal (Jeremiah 31:3, Ephesians 1:4-5)
3. The Father's love is unconditional (Ephesians 2:1-5, Ephesians 2:1-5, Romans 5:8)
4. The Father's love is limitless (1 John 3:1, 1 Corinthians 2:9, Ephesians 2:7, 3:16-19)
5. The Father's love is immutable (Hebrews 13:8, Malachi 3:6, James 1:17)
6. The Father's love is sacrificial (1 John 3:16, 4:9-10, Romans 8:31-32, John 15:13, 10:11, 15)

#### Practical Application

1. When you hear the words, "The Father's Love", what do you think about?
2. Do you find it easy to think about God as a father that loves you? If not, why?
3. How has your life been impacted by the realization that God loves you? Can you try and imagine what your life would be like now if this were missing from your life?
4. Think of some practical ways that you can live everyday remembering that God loves you and try to practice that this week. Try and compare it to other weeks where you maybe are not as concentrated on the Father's love.

It is so easy for us to get caught up in the busyness of life and forget to think about such things as the Father's love. This is a huge detriment to us and we don't even realize it most of the time. May you be ever more aware of the Father's goodness and love towards you as walk out each day.
