1. Impregnated By His Word
2. Chosen By His Grace (Luke 1:28, Ephesians 1:4-6, 1 Corinthians 6:6-11, 1 Corinthians 11:2, Romans 8:1, 1 Corinthians 2:9)
3. Empowered By His Spirit (Ephesians 3:20)

Practical Application

1. Christmas is around the corner. Take some time and reflect on the glory of God. Reflect upon Jesus Christ and the fact that He is our Hope of Glory.
2. As the Angel told Mary of what was going to happen to her, we see the three points above happen in her life. What do you think did she do prior to her visitation to "prepare" her life for it?
3. How can we live our lives to be ready for God to come and use us for His purposes?

May we all enter this season of Christmas mindful of Jesus Christ and all that He has done for us, both through His life and His death. We truly owe all good things to Him! May we remember that this Christmas as we celebrate His Life!
